**\*NOTE:** The greater the Reaction Data (R/T) number from the Threshold Stress Level (TSL-Hi or TSL-Lo) greater the Significant Psychological Reaction (SPR). The greater the difference between the TSL factors and the R/T of a Relevant the greater the stress level. An SPR to a does not necessarily mean the subject is lying but is an indication there may be disagreement between the sub-conscious memory and the conscious mind. Each SPR should be carefully evaluated. REL target questions 8, 12 and 16 are given more weight than the other relevant questions. An Admit makes the issue a Risk Level HIGH which needs to be further evaluated.

**Issue A** is the Introductory for **Issue B and C**. **Issue B** is a Secondary issue and also sets up **Issue C**. **Issue C** is a Primary issue for the test. The first question of each issue is the **Setup** question. The second question for each issue is the **Secondary** question. The third question of each issue the **Primary** question.

Adaptation (ADP) questions are 1, 2, and 3 are only used to adapt the subject to reading and touching the screen. Irrelevant (I/R) questions are 5, 9, 13, and 17 and are only used as stress reducer between issues. Relevant (REL) questions are 6, 7, 8, and 10, 11, 12, and 14, 15, 16.
